Examination Guidelines for Students

Before the Examination

Admit Card: Download your admit card from the university portal at least 7 days before the exam. No student will be allowed to sit for examinations without a valid admit card.

Fee Clearance: Ensure all examination fees and dues are cleared before the examination date.

ID Proof: Carry your university ID card and admit card to the examination hall.

During the Examination

Reporting Time: Arrive at the examination center at least 30 minutes before the scheduled exam time.

Prohibited Items: Mobile phones, electronic devices, programmable calculators, and unauthorized materials are strictly prohibited.

Conduct: Maintain discipline and follow the instructions of invigilators. Any form of malpractice will result in disciplinary action.

Answer Sheets: Write your roll number and other required details clearly on the answer booklet.

After the Examination

Results: Results will be published on the university website and displayed on notice boards.

Re-evaluation/Verification: Students can apply for re-evaluation or answer sheet verification as per university norms within 15 days of result declaration.

Important Instructions

All examinations will be conducted in offline mode at designated examination centers unless otherwise notified.

Students with special needs or requiring accommodations must inform the Controller of Examinations at least 15 days before the exam.

In case of clash of exam dates or any discrepancies, students must report immediately to the Examination Office.
